This year for our Christmas Newsletter we asked our staff for some **interesting facts** and statistics for Toormina High School in 2019!



In 2019 we had 771 students and 101 staff members at Toormina High School and 560 individual classes inc roll classes, sport groups, core subjects, electives etc!

More than 2000 artworks were created over the year by students from years 8 to 12 in Visual Arts and Design.

In 2019 our staff upskilled by attending professional learning for 225 days.

In the first 7 weeks of Term 4, 2019, our Tech Mandatory classes used 43 dozen eggs = 516 eggs total!

It would take about 3000 large potatoes to make all the hash browns that have been sold in the canteen this year. That's a lot of potato!! Also at the canteen this year we made more ice for slushies than was in the iceberg that sank the Titanic!!!! Well almost...

On the Kokoda Challenge our THS students and staff walked 52km = 65,984 steps and climbed the equivalent of 574 floors!
