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Year 7 2022 High Achievers Class Information

What is the High Achievers class?

The High Achievers class has been established to meet the needs of talented, motivated students. Statistical data confirm that each year a group of students with significant differences in innate ability enrol into our school. Research indicates that the learning and socialisation needs of this group are potentially different from the majority of our students. Converting ability into performance is a function of motivation and application. The students in this class will be taught an appropriately broadened, extended and accelerated curriculum. The High Achievers class may also be offered supplementary learning opportunities such as personal interest projects.

The High Achievers class is designed to:

- Provide the appropriate level of academic challenge for students with above average academic achievement
- Promote a positive work ethic which encourages all students to achieve their full potential with likeminded peers
- Enhance innovation, collaboration and creativity in learning

Toormina High School has seen growth in the number of high potential and gifted students applying to our previously known 'extension' class and thus, we have identified the need for an additional class. In 2022, we will offer two High Achievers classes for talented and motivated students. This will allow for up to 60 student placements across these two classes. A reserve list may be established and students invited to fill places should vacancies occur. The class will generally remain as a group for the following subjects:

- English
 PDHPE
- Mathematics
 LOTE (Language
- Music
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- LOTE (Language other than English)
 Gumbaynggirr
- History
- Geography
- Science

Design and Technology subjects will be mixed ability classes of no more than 22 students.

This course structure provides extension class students with plenty of opportunities to meet and work with a large number of their Year 7 peers.

Students who are not maintaining grades and/or motivation may be moved out of the class.

Please note that this form does not replace the Toormina High School enrolment application form which needs to be filled out later in the year.

Selection Criteria for Year 7 2022 High Achievers Class

Students will be selected for the Year 7 High Achievers based on their Achievement Profile as outlined below.

1: Academic Merit:

When determining academic merit the selection committee will consider:

- School reports.
- Competition results.
- Teacher comments and indication of academic merit.

2: Motivation:

Highlights of schooling and future goals:

- Student composition.
- A strong desire to participate in the academic, sporting and cocurricular activities of the school and community.
- A willingness on the part of the applicant's parents to support the ethos and activities of the school.
- Co-curricular activities sport, drama, dance etc.

3: Principal recommendation:

Principals will be asked to comment on:

- Motivation.
- Conduct.
- Contribution to school life.
- Academic achievement.

4. Testing, group activity and interview:

- Students will be invited to attend a testing day on 4 June 2021 from 9am
 11:30am at Toormina High School Library.
- Students will undertake a written test (40 minutes with 5 minutes reading time) and participate in a spontaneous learning challenge with other year 6 applicants.
- Students will also complete an interview (with their parent/s) to discuss their learning strengths, weaknesses and goals.

Application Process

- Sections 1 9 of the application including Student Composition and Commitment Agreement must be completed by applicants. Supporting documentation can be placed with the application. This must be returned to Primary school by <u>Monday 17</u> <u>May 2021.</u>
- 2. The student's primary school is asked to complete **Section 10**.
- 3. The applicant's primary school will then forward the student's application to:

This must be posted by Monday 24 May 2021.

- 4. Students will be advised by telephone no later than Monday 31 May if:
 - a. they are being offered to attend the testing and group activity session on Friday 4th June 2022 and details of how to book the interview.
 - b. they have been placed on the reserve list
 - c. their application has been unsuccessful
- 5. Placement will be determined by a Placement Committee consisting of the Principal, Deputy Principals and Head Teacher Wellbeing.
- 6. The placement committee will meet and determine student placement.
- 7. There is no appeal process; however, the Principal will be able provide feedback to unsuccessful applicants if requested.
- A letter will be sent to all students who were successful at their interview offering them a place in the class. Parents should accept or decline this offer by <u>Wednesday 23 June</u> 2021.

Commitment Agreement

Parents and students will be asked to sign a commitment agreement. This signing of the commitment form represents the recognition by the student and their family of the particular ethos and expectations of the class into which they have gained entry. Successful applicants should see the offer as a privilege and its acceptance as a responsibility. Failure to meet their commitment may result in a student being moved out of the Extension class and into another.


