## Mathematics at Toormina High School

Mathematics at Toormina High School just got a little more exciting!

Have you ever said to yourself or to others "I'm not a maths person?" Some people believe that mathematics is a skill that people are either born with or not. The truth is... "Maths is found everywhere and is for everyone" – Eddie Woo.

This year Jodie Hartmann from the NSW Mathematics Growth Team is joining the Mathematics faculty at Toormina High School. Her role is to support the faculty in enhancing the students experience of mathematics and encouraging students to adopt what is known as a 'mathematical growth mindset'. Students will be exposed to open-ended activities that promote thinking, problem solving, communication and reasoning.

#### What is the Mathematics Growth Team?

The mathematics growth team, a part of the Best In Class Teaching Unit, amplifies the impact of expert mathematics teaching at targeted schools to:

- strengthen mathematics leaders and build a new generation of mathematics teachers across NSW public schools
- support the use of evidence-based, best-practice assessment and teaching practices among mathematics educators.

Currently, the Mathematics Growth Team consists of 13 school-based expert mathematics secondary teachers. Ms Jodie Hartmann is the trainer based at Toormina High School

Ms Hartmann will be working with teachers and students to develop mathematics skills and knowledge at THS.

#### Lesson studies and observations

As part of the evaluation of the Mathematics Growth Team project, mathematics lessons across the school will have teacher demonstration and teaching recorded for the purpose of evaluation. These recordings are shared securely with the research team and any incidental capturing of students will not be published. Ms Hartmann has been provided with video recording equipment and will be conducting these lesson observations late Term One and early Term Two.

Importantly, the data collected aims to analyse the needs of the school and its mathematics teachers and for future state-wide evidence. In no way will students or teachers be identified or disclosed.

## Principal's Column

It was with great excitement that we welcomed our students and staff back last week to the start of the 2022 school year. Hopefully, this year will be a more settled and less disrupted year than the previous two years. Thank you to all of our parents and staff that collected the Rapid Antigen Tests (RATs) prior to returning to school and assisting in the surveillance testing program, reporting cases to NSW Health, Toormina High School and keeping positive cases at home.

I have recently received a number of letters from parents withdrawing permission to vaccinate students on school grounds. I would like to take this opportunity to answer some of the questions around vaccinations and testing in school.

Vaccinations in schools require parent permission to occur and as such students without permission cannot be vaccinated. Despite what some parents may have read online, sending your child to school does not constitute giving the principal permission to vaccinate your child. I can also ensure you that there is no plan to engage NSW Health in vaccinating students against COVID19 at Toormina High School.

We will not be testing students at school using RATs or PCR tests. The RATs have been provided free of charge to families to allow them the opportunity to test their child at home. It is, however, important that student who do test positive remain home until they receive the clearance text from NSW Health after logging the test result on the Service NSW App. This is usually about 7 days after the initial positive test result is logged. This text also needs to be provided to the school upon your child's return to school.

This week will see the roll out of the next round of RATs to students and staff. Students will receive their allocation at school commencing Wednesday. Information was sent through the Sentral Parent Portal and Skoolbag advising parents about this process and to contact the school if they wish to pick these tests up or do not wish for the tests to be issued to students at all. I encourage you to use the RATs and continue supporting Toormina High School.

I was extremely proud of our schools' Higher School Certificate results for 2021. We received a total of 13 Band 6 results, the most since 2010. We continue to be one of the top performing comprehensive State High Schools on the Mid North Coast of NSW. There has been a very steady growth in our Band 4, 5 and 6 results over the past few years resulting in students who remain at Toormina High School for year 11 and 12 outperforming students who leave Toormina to attend the other public schools.

Congratulations to Mariah Anderson (4 Band 6's), Sharnte Cannon (4 Band 6's), Ellena Cheers-Flavell (2 Band 6's), Myah Harrison (1 Band 6), Amy Newcombe (1 Band 6) and Cooper Bake-Smith (1 Band 6). A Band 6 is a final mark between 90 and 100. These students achieved outstanding results across a range of subjects taught by Lisa Mullan, Anita Milne, Adam Berrada, Richard Raward and Matthew Francis. There were also a large number of students who achieved Band 4 and 5 results. Overall, 81% of our students who sat HSC examinations in 2021 received a Band 3 or better (final mark between 60 and 100). We as a community should be very, very proud of our Year 12 cohort!

#### Sentral Parent Portal

Toormina High School uses Sentral, which is a web-based software platform that manages school administration and student data. Our preferred method of communication to our parents and carers is through the Sentral Parent Portal. This is available as a convenient mobile phone app called "Sentral for Parents" on both Apple and Android devices.

Through the Sentral Parent Portal you will be able to access information for your child/children such as:

- Absences (to view absences and advise us of your child's absence)
- Newsfeed
- Newsletters
- Timetables (via Web Portal button)
- Attendance summary (via Web Portal button)
- School Reports (via Web Portal button)
- Various Resources such as Exam timetables, Subject Selection Guides, information and instruction documents
- Book in for parent teacher interviews at the relevant time

To download and install the Sentral for Parents app please see the instructions on the Toormina High School website > Links > Sentral for Students and Parents > Parent Portal Registration Instructions > click on Instructions: https://toormina-h.schools.nsw.gov.au/links/parent-portal-registration-instructions.html

After registering, you will need to input your unique access key to link to your child's information. The access keys will be provided to new parents at the start of the 2022 school year. For parents with older students at Toormina High School who have already registered on the Sentral for Parents app, the new Year 7 student should be automatically added to your app.

For security reasons, an access key can only be used by one registered user. An additional key/s can be provided for another parent/carer if this is required or convenient.

Note: to be able to view the documents attached in the Sentral for Parents app, your phone will need a PDF (Portable Document File) Reader. Many phones will already have a PDF reader installed, but if your phone won't open the PDF files, you can choose one of the free PDF Reader apps from the App store or Google Play store to download & install.

Access keys were emailed to new Year 7 parents on Tuesday 8th February. If any new parents have not received this email, please call the school & request your Sentral Parent Portal access key.


