Application Process

1. Applications must be submitted to Toormina High School by 4pm on Thursday 21 July 2022 to Mrs Gaye Devoy (Head Teacher Wellbeing) - either hand written **or** completed on Google form: <https://forms.gle/zQf3TYChLUFo1SdWA>
2. Scholarship recipients will be determined by the Scholarship Committee consisting of the Principal, Deputy Principal (Year 7 2023) and Head Teacher Wellbeing.
3. The Scholarships committee will meet and determine recipients.
4. A letter will be sent to all applicants informing applicants if:
 - a. they are being awarded a scholarship
 - b. they have been placed on the reserve list
 - c. their application has been unsuccessful
5. There is no appeal process; however, the Principal will be able to provide feedback to unsuccessful applicants if requested.
6. Only students currently enrolled at a school affiliated with the Bongil Bongil Community of Schools are eligible to apply.
