

# Sport 2023 – Term 3

Dear Parents/guardians and students

**Sports selections** for Term 3 2023 will be held on **Thursday (8<sup>th</sup> June)**. Students will be emailed a link to their sports selections on Thursday morning and will be given time in class to make selections. A list of sports on offer and a description of the sport is attached. It would be great if you could have conversations with your child/ren regarding their preferred sports. Please note that some sports have a **fee attached** and this is cost of the sport per week. Some sports require students to bring their own equipment or have completed specific courses, these requirements are in the description of each sport.

There is **limited availability** for some sports, so students will select three preferences. Preferences will be allocated on a first come first serve basis. If there are not enough students to run a sport, students will be allocated their other preferences where possible.

Permission notes will be sent electronically to parents/guardians. Sports that are **offsite require permission** from parents/guardians and these notes need **to be returned before the end of term 2 2023**. Students who have not return permission notes will be reallocated to an onsite sport, without choice of sport.

**Students will NOT be able to change sports** due to the new payment system and are asked to make wise choices on their sports selections. Students that repeatedly forget money will be reallocated to an onsite sport and will not be given a choice of an offsite sport for Term 4, 2023. This is due to the popularity of offsite sports and giving students that will attend these sports priority.

The **new payment system** will continue to be used in Term 3. Parents will be able to make online payments week by week or for the full term. Students will also be able to make payments at the office for sport using EFTPOS or cash at any time during the week **until recess on a Wednesday**. There will no longer be a cash collection bucket at the beginning of sport. Due to this new system no sport changes can be made as students are allocated a sport through this financial system that connects their payments. If your child/ren misses sport, they must see the office to have the payment switched to the following week.
