Year 7 2019 Extension Class Information

What is the Extension Class?

The extension class has been established to meet the needs of talented, motivated students. Statistical data confirm that each year a group of students with significant differences in innate ability enrol into our school. Research indicates that the learning and socialisation needs of this group are potentially different from the majority of our students. Converting ability into performance is a function of motivation and application. The students in this class will be taught an appropriately broadened, extended and accelerated curriculum. They will be challenged, motivated and inspired.

Students who are not maintaining grades and/or motivation may be moved out of the class.

The class will remain as a group for the following subjects:

- English
- Music
- PDHPE
- LOTE (Language other than English) - Gumbaynggirr
- History
- Geography

The Mathematics Faculty will grade students within the first 5 weeks on each student's ability for this particular subject.

Personal Development, Health and Physical Education (PDHPE) Faculty may group students into single sex classes.

Design and Technology subjects will be mixed ability classes of no more than 22 students.

This course structure provides extension class students with plenty of opportunities to meet and work with a large number of their Year 7 peers.

Please note that this form does not replace the Toormina High School enrolment application form which needs to be filled out later in the year.

Selection Criteria for Year 7 2019 Extension Class

Students will be selected for the Year 7 Extension class based on their Achievement Profile as outlined below.

1: **Academic Merit:**

When determining academic merit the selection committee will consider:

- School reports.
- Competition results.
- NAPLAN results (from Year 5).
- Teacher comments and indication of academic merit.

2: **Motivation:**

Highlights of schooling and future goals:

- Student composition.
- A strong desire to participate in the academic, sporting and co-curricular activities of the school and community.
- A willingness on the part of the applicant's parents to support the ethos and activities of the school.
- Co-curricular activities – sport, drama, dance etc.

3: **Principal recommendation:**

Principals will be asked to comment on:

- Motivation.
- Conduct.
- Contribution to school life.
- Academic achievement.

4. **Interview:**

- Students will be asked to discuss their learning strengths, weaknesses and goals.

Application Process

1. **Sections 1 – 10** of the application including Student Composition and Commitment Agreement must be completed by applicants. Supporting documentation can be placed with the application.

This must be returned to Primary school by Monday 4 June 2018.

2. The student's primary school is asked to complete **Section 11**.

3. The applicant's **primary school will then forward the student's application to:**

4. Placement will be determined by a Placement Committee consisting of the Principal, Deputy Principals and Head Teacher Welfare.
5. The placement committee will meet and determine student placement.
6. A letter will be sent to all applicants informing applicants if:
 - a. they are being offered an interview
 - b. they have been placed on the reserve list
 - c. their application has been unsuccessful
7. There is no appeal process; however, the Principal will be able provide feedback to unsuccessful applicants if requested.
8. A letter will be sent to all students who were successful at their interview offering them a place in the class. **Parents should accept or decline this offer by Friday 31 August 2018.**

Class Composition

The extension class will consist of 30 students. Up to three places may be held for late enrolments and/or out of area placements (students who have moved to the Coffs Harbour area). These places will be filled by students on the reserve list in the first week of term one.

Commitment Agreement

Parents and students will be asked to sign a commitment agreement. This signing of the commitment form represents the recognition by the student and their family of the particular ethos and expectations of the class into which they have gained entry. Successful applicants should see the offer as a privilege and its acceptance as a responsibility. Failure to meet their commitment may result in a student being moved out of the Extension class and into another.
