Year 7 students will be participating in our Bonding Excursion to the Coffs Coast Adventure Centre. The venue is an outdoor educational facility located in Bonville. Students will be able to participate in a variety of activities including the Giant Swing, Zorb Ball, Leap of Faith, Mega Drop and more. Students will be bussed to and from the Centre from school.

Make Online Payments

It is now possible for parents to make online payments to the school for amounts owing for students, via a secure payment page hosted by Westpac. Payments can be made using either a Visa or MasterCard credit or debit card. The payment page is accessed from the front page of the schools website at <http://www.toorminah.schools.nsw.edu.au/> by selecting \$ Make a payment

Items that can be paid include voluntary school contributions, subject contributions, excursions, sales to students and creative and practical arts activities (these include band, drama and dance). There is also a category called Other. This to cover items not covered in the previous headings.

When you access the \$ Make a payment you must enter:

- the students name, and
- Year group – Year 7 2018
- date of birth.

These details are entered each time you make a payment as student information is not held within the payment system.

This is a secure payment system hosted by Westpac to ensure that your credit/debit card details are captured in a secure manner, these details are not passed back to the school.

You have the ability to check and change any details of the payment before the payment is processed. Receipts can be emailed and/or printed.

Details of the payments are passed daily to the school where they will be receipted against your child's account. As a receipt has been issued from the payment page a further receipt will not be issued by the school.
