Application Process

- 1. Sections 1 2 of the application. This must be returned to Toormina High School by Friday 29 June 2018 to Mrs Laura McRae.
- 2. Scholarship recipients will be determined by the Scholarship Committee consisting of the Principal, Deputy Principals and Head Teacher Wellbeing.
- 3. The Scholarships committee will meet and determine recipients.
- 4. A letter will be sent to all applicants informing applicants if:
- a. they are being awarded a scholarship
- b. they have been placed on the reserve list
- c. their application has been unsuccessful
- 5. There is no appeal process; however, the Principal will be able provide feedback to unsuccessful applicants if requested.
- 6. Only students currently enrolled at a school affiliated with the Bongil Bongil Community of Schools are eligible to apply.
