²/³ cup warm water 2 cups bread flour 40 grams butter, melted 1 egg, beaten



40 grams milk powder 1/4 cup chocolate chips 2 tablespoons cocoa 2 tablespoons flour, sifted

- Docks
- 1 tablespoon water 1/4 cup apricot jam, heated METHOD 1 Mix yeast with sugar and salt. 2 Add warm water, cover and allow to sit until mixture is frothy (about 10 minutes). 3 Sift the bread flour into a large bowl and make a well. When yeast mixture is ready, pour it into the well. 4 Add melted butter, egg and milk powder. Mix until you have a soft dough. 5 Lightly flour your bench and knead the dough until it is smooth and elastic. 6 Place in an oiled bowl and leave to prove until doubled in size (about 20 minutes). 7 Preheat your oven to 200°C. 8 Gently knead chocolate chips into your dough. Divide

dough into 10 portions and shape each into a ball. 9 Place balls on a baking tray side by side. Cover and leave to prove for another 10 minutes. 10 To make the cross paste, mix cocoa, extra flour and water. 11 Pipe cross onto buns. 12 Bake for 10 minutes. 13 Reduce heat to 180°C and continue to bake for another 5 minutes or until bun is cooked and golden brown in colour. 14 Remove from oven and glaze with heated apricot jam.

Principal's Column
